# We are currently vaccinating across both Group 2 and Group 3

<b>Group 1</b>	Includes border and MIQ workers and their household contacts.
<b>Group 2</b>	Includes frontline health workers, people working and living in long-term residential care, and older Māori and Pacific people and the people who live with and care for them.
<b>Group 3</b>	<p>Includes people aged 65 and over and those with underlying conditions and disabilities*.</p> <p>*The people we're currently vaccinating in Group 3 include some people aged 65 and older and some people residing in rural areas.</p> <p>We're vaccinating people in Group 3 in rural areas with small populations because of the time and cost associated with visiting the location several times.</p> <p>We'll continue to invite more people in Group 3 to book through July and August.</p> <p><b>If you are in Group 3, you don't need to do anything right now.</b> We'll contact you by text, phone call or letter when it's your turn.</p>
<b>Group 4</b>	Includes everyone, aged 16 or over. Group 4 vaccinations will start in late-July.

## Please note:

- Timeframes may vary and we will let you know if our planned timings change.
- We don't currently have any vaccination drop-in clinics – all vaccinations are by appointment only.
